
It will not only lead us through breathtaking landscapes, but also follow the traces of the wars, political upheavals and autonomy aspirations of the last century. Our hope is that this will offer us tools and tenets helpful for implementing peace in Europe.

We will explore memorial sites in the Dolomites and follow historical routes along the mountain front in South Tirol during the First World War, on our way to Lake Garda. The war cemetery in Costermano, where we will help to preserve graves and look at the fate of those killed in action, is our goal.

Our route continues to Slovenia, where we will discuss the events of the First World War in Kobarid and in the Soca Valley on the pathway of the "Walk of Peace".

Swimming in Lake Garda and explorations of Verona and the alpine world in South Tirol will be further activities.

WANDERLUST and some alpine experience are prerequisites for participation in our mountain walks. You will need to be able to cope with 400 to 800m in altitude and 5 to 7 hours of walking.
